

### Free Rebuild Program

lowernine.org is offering a free rebuilding program for the residents of the Lower 9<sup>th</sup> Ward. We have skilled volunteers who will perform the bulk of the labor. Rather than paying what a contractor would charge, you will only have to pay for the materials. **Depending upon the condition and size of your home, materials cost an average of \$20-\$50,000 (electrical and plumbing materials average \$1,500-\$2,000 each). You must provide the money for materials, and as well as pay for a private licensed plumber and electrician to do the electric, gas, and AC. We are not able to assist with plumbing, electric and gas.** NOTE: Due to the limited number of volunteers we can train and organize, we can only accept a small number of jobs at any one time. The type of rebuild work we can do depends largely on the skills of our current volunteers. We will contact you if your application is accepted.
